Requests to enroll in a 199 course for a letter grade

The Academic Senate approved special studies courses to be issued a Passed/Not Passed grading option. Exceptions to enroll in a 199 course are rarely granted. Petitions will not be approved if the student is requesting a letter grade to increase their GPA, would prefer a letter grade for graduate school applications, or to reflect increased workload in the course.

- Include a personal statement providing academic justification for receiving a letter grade in a 199 course.
- Include a letter of support from the faculty sponsor (or professor of record), your major adviser, and/or department adviser on official departmental letterhead in a sealed envelope.
- Include supporting documentation if applicable.
